

MAFMC Vision and Strategic Plan

 Ecosystem related issues ranked high on the list of concerns raised by stakeholders across all user groups

 Objective 15: "Advance an ecosystem approach to fisheries management through development of EAFM Guidance Document"



EAFM Strategy Allows for...

Transition from single-species to ecosystem level management

Movement towards a definition of OY which takes into account interactions at multiple dimensions of the ecosystem and....


Recognizes that humans are a major component of marine ecosystems.



EAFM Guidance Document

- Umbrella for coordination of ecosystem considerations across existing FMPs
- Non-regulatory document designed to provide policy guidance with regulatory actions taken through existing FMP structure
- Best approach as MAFMC managed species exist in numerous ecosystems and a substantial portion of these are outside of MAFMC jurisdiction (i.e., 3 east coast Councils and ASMFC) (Not FEP)
